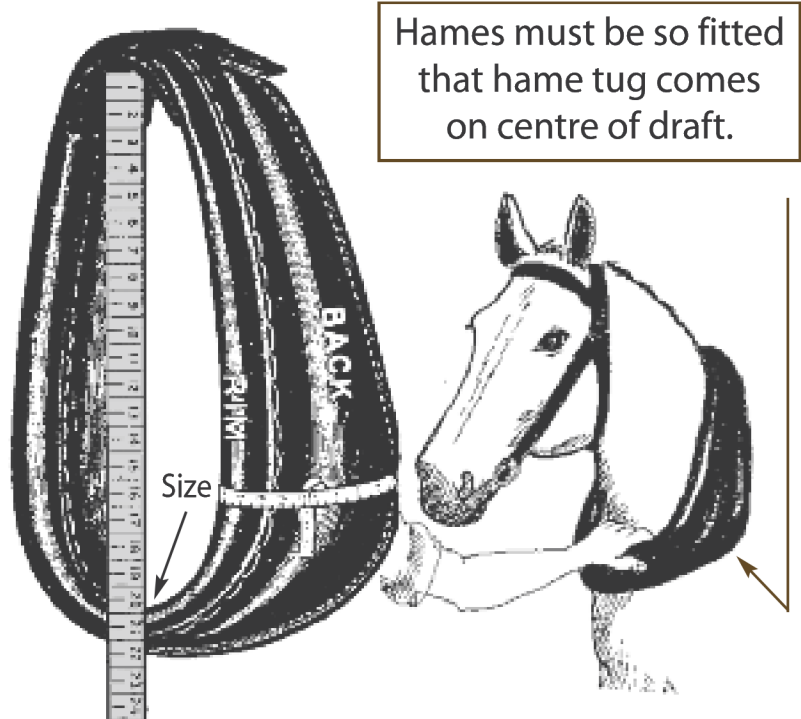
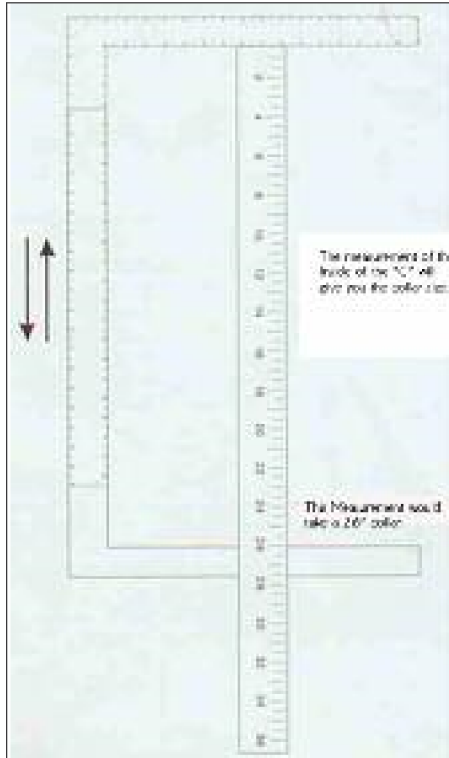


HOW TO MEASURE A HORSE FOR A COLLAR

Length from top to base of neck at proper position of collar. Line should be straight, not conforming to the horse's body. If possible, measure a collar which fits the horse, using the inside dimensions of the collar, as shown. You can make a makeshift measure by using two carpenter squares. (If you only have one cut another out of cardboard.) Place them together to form a "C" in front of the withers, place the bottom of the "C" two inches in front of the shoulders. Be sure to allow finger room at the base of the throat. Measure the inside of the "C" to obtain the size. Another option is to measure the circumference of the widest part of the front leg (usually under the arm pit). This has been giving us the collar size within a inch or so.
